- Next up, 30 Super Standard, 30hp Rookies, 30hp Sports competing first qualifying round
- Next up, Finals for 15hp, 25hp, 30hp Standard, 300cc Modified.
- Second qualification round for 30hp Super Standard, 30hp Rookies and 30hp Sports followed immediately by finals.
